Capturing Atmosphere: Introduction

Date & Time: Saturday October 20th, 2018, 10am – 4pm (with additional, optional finishing hour until 5pm)

Cost: £40, plus £5 for lunch.

Details:

This workshop is an introduction to plein air techniques available to help artists make the most out of their on-site drawings; with a view to developing atmospheric, dynamic paintings back in the studio. We will spend half of the day sketching in the grounds and woodland of Halecat House, and then spend the afternoon translating our marks into finished paintings.

This course is not medium specific, the plein air techniques will serve a watercolourist as well as someone using oils or acrylics. Whilst some materials will be available at the studio, I recommend bringing your own. This is in order that you become familiar and confident with the tools you have to hand when you are working outside of class. If you have any questions, please ask.

Gilding: a festive introduction

Date: Friday November 30th – Saturday December 1st, 2018 10am – 4pm (with additional optional finishing hour until 5pm)

Cost: £80, plus £10 for lunches. Cost includes all materials.

Details:

You will be learning the basics of traditional water gilding, as you make your own Christmas decorations. Gilding is the method used to glue precious metals, such as copper and gold, to different surfaces. Water gilding, which you will be learning, is the original method, and whilst more complex than modern techniques, it achieves a

smoother, mirror finish. Perfect for reflecting those fairy lights! There will be copper, silver and gold leaf available to choose from* as well as festive snacks and drinks to keep us going.

There is lunch available, at a cost of £5 per day, provided by the fabulous Hazelmere Tea House from Grange-over-Sands. If you prefer, you are more than welcome to bring your own lunch. Please make us aware of any dietary requirements at the time of booking.

*Genuine gold leaf is available but at an extra cost of £1 a sheet to be paid on the day.
